RE: Curb-side malt beverage and intoxicating liquor delivery

While we are under the Emergency Declaration due to the COVID-19 pandemic, many restaurants and taverns throughout Wisconsin have been engaging in "curb-side" pick up orders of beer, wine and liquor. Under normal circumstances, a license holder would need to file an amendment to their license application to extend the premises for curb side services. **However, the State of Wisconsin and City of South Milwaukee will not be enforcing this requirement while under the emergency declaration.**

While we encourage all license holders that wish to engage in curb side service to amend their applications to extend premises, **you may engage in it immediately.** If you do wish to apply, please do so by calling the City Clerk and requesting a form that you can return by mail as we are limiting the number of people physically appearing at city hall during the Emergency Declaration. Please note the following laws remain in place while you are engaging in curb-side service:

1. All fermented malt beverages, intoxicating liquors and wine must be served in original packaging.
2. All sales must be on premises or at curb-side.

As a city we are committed to assist you through this trying time. Be safe.
