**157th Maneuver
Enhancement Brigade**

The shoulder sleeve insignia of the 157th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade dates to 1979 when the unit was known as the 57th Field Artillery Brigade. The insignia consists of a vertical yellow rectangle that is arched at the top and bottom. A red arrowhead points upward to the center of a blue gunsight and three blue waves are positioned below the arrow.

Red and yellow are the colors traditionally associated with Field Artillery and recall the predecessor's designation. The arrowhead denotes the unit's long association with the 32nd Infantry Division and the gunsight symbolizes the Brigade's former mission. The waves at the base refer to the many waterways of the State of Wisconsin, which is a Native American word meaning "gathering of the waters."

The 157th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade organized Sep. 18, 1917 at Camp MacArthur, Texas, as the 57th Field Artillery Brigade, 32nd Division with personnel from the Wisconsin and Michigan National Guard. It fought in the Alsace 1918, Aisne-Marne, Champaign 1918, Oise-Aisne and Meuse-Argonne campaigns. It reorganized in Wisconsin in 1920 and fought in the New Guinea, Leyte and Luzon campaigns with the 32nd Division where it earned the Philippine Presidential Unit Citation. The unit reorganized after the war as an artillery brigade in the Wisconsin National Guard and it mobilized in 1961 for a year of stateside service during the Berlin Crisis. The brigade was separated from the 32nd Division in 1967. The unit on Sep. 1, 2008 was designated the 157th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade.

64th Troop Command

The shoulder sleeve insignia of the Wisconsin Army National Guard and the 64th Troop Command Brigade dates to 1952 when the insignia became the symbol for the state headquarters detachment. It consists of a black and white badger centered on a red shield. The red signifies one of the nation's three colors. The badger is from the crest of the State Seal of Wisconsin and alludes to the state nickname of "The Badger State."

Other Wisconsin National Guard units started wearing this insignia in 1967 when the 32nd Infantry Division was reorganized as a brigade. The 64th Troop Command name is inspired by the 64th Infantry Brigade, which fought as part of the 32nd Division in World War I. Today, the insignia is worn by Wisconsin Army National Guard Soldiers at Joint Force Headquarters-Wisconsin and the 64th Troop Command Brigade.

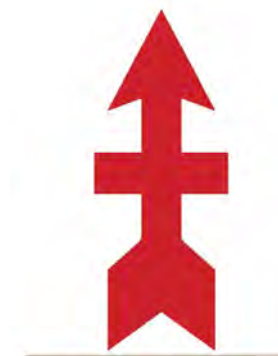
The shoulder sleeve insignia of the 32nd Infantry Brigade Combat team dates to 1918 when the unit was known as the 32nd Division. The insignia is a vertical red arrow with a horizontal red bar at the center. The division selected the symbol shortly after World War I because it had "pierced through every line the enemy put before them."

The 32nd Infantry Brigade Combat Team was constituted on July 18, 1917 as the 32nd Division with personnel from the Wisconsin and Michigan National Guard. The division forged its identity as the Red Arrow in World War I in the Alsace 1918, Aisne-Marne, Oise-Aisne, and Meuse-Argonne campaigns. The division reorganized in both states after World War I and would fight in Papua, New Guinea, Leyte and Luzon campaigns in World War II, earning a Presidential Unit Citation. The division reorganized entirely in Wisconsin after the war and mobilized in 1961 for a year of stateside service during the Berlin Crisis. The Army reorganized the 32nd Infantry Division in 1967 into the Wisconsin Army National Guard's largest brigade. It deployed in its entirety to Iraq in 2009.

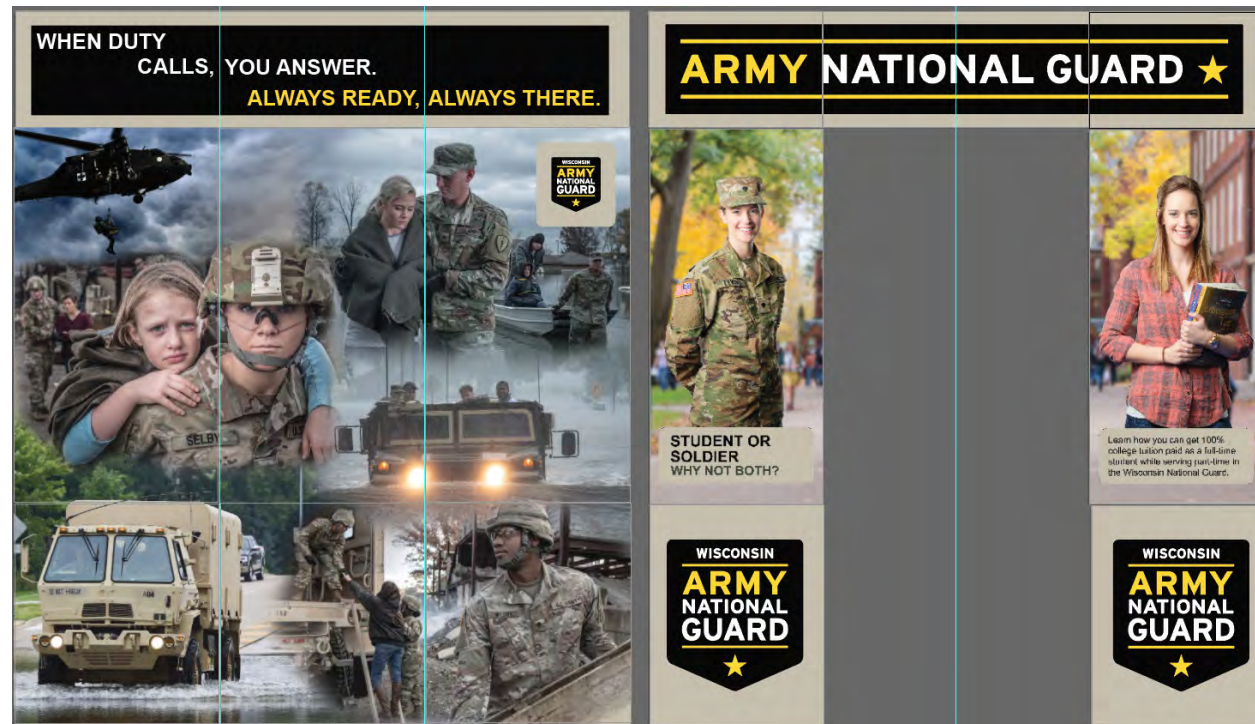
